## REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS AND DEATHS AMENDMENT.

### ANALYSIS.

Title.  
1. Short Title.

2. Penalty for not informing of birth of child may be recovered within two years.

### A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1875." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Registration of Births and Deaths Amendment Act, 1892." Short Title.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in "The Justices of the Peace Act, 1882," or any other Act, any information or complaint to be heard in a summary way before a Resident Magistrate or any two Justices of the Peace for or in respect of any offence against the provisions of section sixteen of "The Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1875," for refusing or neglecting to give information of the birth of any child, or for the recovery of any penalty under that section, may be laid at any time within two years next after the date of the birth of such child. Penalty for not informing of birth of child may be recovered within two years.
