A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to further amend "The Rating on Unimproved Value Act, 1896." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Rating on Unimproved Value Amendment Act, 1905"; and it shall be read together with and as part of "The Rating on Unimproved Value Act, 1896" (hereinafter termed "the principal Act"). Short Title

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in section twenty of the principal Act, the local authority of any district in which the said Act is in force may submit to the ratepayers in the manner prescribed by "The Local Elections Act, 1904," a proposal that the system of rating on unimproved values shall apply to all or any of the rates mentioned in section twenty, and the result of the poll on such proposal shall have effect accordingly. Section 20 of principal Act amended.
