## A BILL INTITULED

- An Act to further continue the Operation of Part I of the War Title. Legislation Amendment Act, 1916, and its Amendments (relating to the Restriction of Rent).
- 5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :--

1. This Act may be cited as the Rent Restriction Continuance Short Title. Act, 1925.

- 2. (1.) Part I of the War Legislation Amendment Act, 1916, Further extension of 10 and the several amendments thereof, in so far as those enactments duration of law as to restriction of rent. are now in force, shall continue in force until the thirty-first day of August, nineteen hundred and twenty-six, and shall then be deemed to be repealed.
- 15(2.) Section two of the Rent Restriction Act, 1924, is hereby Consequential repeal. repealed.
