A BILL INTITULED

An Acr to amend the State Advances Act, 1913.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the State Advances Amendment short Title. Act, 1915, and shall be read with the State Advances Act, 1913 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Section thirty-one of the principal Act is hereby amended by Section 31 of 10 adding thereto the following: "A statement of every such transfer principal Act shall within ten days thereafter be laid before both Houses of Parliament if then in session, or if not, then within ten days after the commencement of the next ensuing session."
