A BILL INTITULED

Provided that no person shall be required to give notice under section five of the principal Act before 20 commencing the stacking of timber.

5. Section seventeen of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after paragraph (b), the following paragraph:—

⁽ⁱ(bb) Providing for the installation in buildings 25 of safety-devices for the protection of persons employed therein as windowcleaners ".
