A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to provide for the Application of the Shipping and Seamen Act, 1908, to Samoa. Title.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. (1.) This Act may be cited as the Samoa (Shipping) Act, 1925, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Samoa Act, 1921. Short Title and commencement.

10 (2.) This Act shall come into operation on the day on which His Majesty's assent thereto is notified by the Governor-General by a Proclamation published in the *Gazette*, or on such later date (being not later than three months after the date of the Proclamation) as is specified in that behalf in the Proclamation.

15 2. The Governor-General may, from time to time, by Order in Council, apply to Samoa such of the provisions of the Shipping and Seamen Act, 1908, and its amendments as he thinks fit, with such adaptations as he considers necessary to make the said provisions applicable to Samoa. Application of Shipping and Seamen Act, 1908, to Samoa.
