### A BILL INTITULED

#### **An Act to amend the Stamp Duties Act 1954**

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Stamp Duties Amendment Act 1956, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Stamp Duties Act 1954 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Exemption from stamp duty of agreements for sale of goods—Section one hundred and forty of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding to subsection four the following paragraph:

“(i) Any agreement made for or relating to the sale of goods, wares, or merchandise (not being a hire purchase agreement within the meaning of the Hire Purchase Agreements Act 1939).”
