## A BILL INTITULED

# An Act to make lawful the intended marriage between Thomas George Stockman and Rosalina Terewai Howe

- WHEREAS Thomas George Stockman of Aria, superannuitant, and, Rosalina Terewai Howe of Aria, housewife, wish to marry: And whereas Thomas George Stockman is Rosalina Terewai Howe's mother's half-brother: And whereas the intended marriage is within the degrees of prohibition contained in the Second Schedule to the Marriage Act 1955: And whereas Thomas George Stockman and Rosalina Terewai Howe have been living together as man and wife for 27 years and the relationship between them has produced 4 children: And whereas the removal of the prohibition on their intended marriage cannot be attained otherwise than by legislation:
- BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
  - 1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Stockman-Howe Marriage Act 1984.
- 20 **2. Removal of prohibition**—Section 15 of, and the Second Schedule to, the Marriage Act 1955 shall not apply to a
