OST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN-We, Your Majesty's most Preamble. dutiful and loyal subjects the Representatives of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, towards raising the supplies which have been cheerfully granted to Your Majesty in this Session of Parliament, have 5 resolved to grant unto Your Majesty the sum hereinafter mentioned.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as

- 1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Treasury Bills Act, Short Title. 10 1870.
- 2. Towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty Colonial Treasurer during the present Session, it shall be lawful for the Colonial Treasurer authorized to make out Treasury Bills to be made the amount of fifty out at the Colonial Treasury, for any sum or sums of money not thousand pounds; such Bills to be made all such Treasury Bills shall be prepared made out and issued under the authority of and in the manner prescribed by "The Treasury Bills Regularity Act 1868" the authority of and in the manner prescribed by "The Treasury Bills Ration Act, 1868." Regulation Act, 1868," and "The Treasury Bills Regulations Act Amendment Act, 1869," and may bear interest at any rate not exceeding 20 fourpence (4d.) for every one hundred pounds (£100) by the day, in respect of the whole moneys contained therein: Provided always that the currency of the said Bills shall in no case be made to extend beyond the thirty-first day of October, one thousand eight hundred
