A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT empowering the Timaru Borough Council to expend Moneys on the Maintenance and Repair of certain Streets not vested in the Corporation of the Borough. Title.

5 WHEREAS the Timaru Harbour Board (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") is the owner of certain freehold lands situated within the boundaries of the Borough of Timaru, being land vested in the Board by the Timaru Harbour Board Act 1876 Amendment Act, 1881, particulars of which are set out in the Schedule hereto: And whereas Preamble.  
10 the said lands have from time to time been subdivided by the Board for the purpose of leasing the same: And whereas, in order to provide access for past, present, and future lessees to the land so leased as aforesaid, the Board has from time to time constructed certain streets through and over the said lands (but the said streets still remain vested  
15 in the Board), and the Board may in the future construct other streets for the same purpose through and over the said lands or other lands hereafter reclaimed adjacent thereto: And whereas it has been found desirable that the said streets and such other streets should remain  
20 vested in the Board, but that the Timaru Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") shall have power to expend moneys on the repair and maintenance of the said streets and such other streets as if the same were vested in the Corporation of the Borough of Timaru (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation"):

25 BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Timaru Borough Empowering Act, 1929. Short Title.
