WHEREAS it has been considered expedient to provide for the Preamble.  
better accommodation and instruction of the inhabitants of the  
5 District of Tauranga: And whereas, in order to carry out such  
desire, it is intended to vest in the proper authorities certain lands  
mentioned in the Schedule hereto :

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New  
Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,  
10 as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act is " The Tauranga School Site Short Title.  
Act, 1884."

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day of Commencing opera-

15 3. Upon the coming into operation of this Act, " The Education Acts incorporated.  
Act, 1877," and " The Education Reserves Act, 1877," shall be, and  
they are hereby, incorporated herewith.

4. The pieces of land mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall be, Lands vested in
