A BILL INTITULED

An Act to empower the Wellington City Council to raise a Special Title. Loan in connection with its Abattoir.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :--

1. This Act may be cited as the Wellington City Abattoir Loan Short Title. Act, 1919.

2. In this Act, if not inconsistent with the context,—

"City" means the City of Wellington:

"Council" means the Wellington City Council.

Interpretation.

3. The Wellington City Council may raise a special loan of not Power to raise loan more than fifteen thousand pounds under the Local Bodies' Loans in respect of 15 Act, 1913, by special order, and without taking the steps described under sections eight to twelve of that Act, for the following purposes :--

- (a.) For recouping all moneys expended prior to the raising of the loan out of or owing to District Fund for capital expenditure and preliminary expenses in connection with the abattoir:
- (b.) For extensions and additions of the present abattoir buildings and plant.
