BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Wellington City Empower- Short Title
ing and Amendment Act, 1921-22.

2. Section three of the Wellington City Empowering and
10 Amendment Act, 1912, is hereby amended by repealing the words
“No such by-laws shall authorize charges to be made in respect of
zoological gardens on any Sunday” at the commencement of sub-
section three of the said section, and by substituting for such
words the following words: “Such by-laws may authorize charges to
15 be made in respect of the said zoological gardens on any day, includ-
ing Sunday.”
