BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

1. This Act may be cited as the Wellington City Empower-Short Title ing and Amendment Act, 1921–22.

2. Section three of the Wellington City Empowering and Amendment of 10 Amendment Act, 1912, is hereby amended by repealing the words Wellington City "No such by-laws shall authorize charges to be made in respect of Amendment Act, zoological gardens on any Sunday" at the commencement of sub-section three of the said section, and by substituting for such words the following words : "Such by-laws may authorize charges to

15 be made in respect of the said zoological gardens on any day, including Sunday."
