A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Wellington City Milk-supply Act, 1910, and the Wellington City Empowering and Amendment Act, 1911. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Wellington City Milk-supply Amendment Act, 1914. Short Title.

2. (1.) Section five of the Wellington City Milk-supply Act, 1910 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), is hereby amended— Amendments of Wellington City Milk-supply Act, 1910.

(a.) By repealing the words "in the manner prescribed by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1908," at the end of the section; and

15 (b.) By substituting in lieu thereof the words "raised under the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, by special order and without taking the steps described in sections eight to twelve of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913."

(2.) Section eight of the principal Act is hereby amended by 20 repealing the following words at the beginning of the section: "Subject to the provisions of this Act relating to milk brought into the city by road."

(3.) Section nine of the principal Act is hereby repealed.

(4.) Paragraph (f) of section eleven of the principal Act is 25 hereby repealed.

(5.) Paragraph (b) of section eighteen of the principal Act is hereby repealed.

3. Section six of the Wellington City Empowering and Amendment Act, 1911, is hereby repealed.

Amendment of Wellington City Empowering and Amendment Act, 1911.

*New.*

3A. The power conferred by section six of the Wellington City Empowering and Amendment Act, 1911, shall be exercisable only in respect of milk-stations in which the business of selling and distributing milk in wholesale quantities is being carried on on the commencement of this Act.
