2. Governor in Council may withdraw land from reservation under "Waste Lands Act, 1858."

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Waste Lands Act, 1858." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Waste Lands Act Amendment Act, 1875." Short Title.

2. It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council, by Proclamation in the *New Zealand Gazette*, to withdraw from reservation the whole or part of any land excepted from sale and reserved to Her Majesty, or that may hereafter be excepted from sale and reserved to Her Majesty, under the provisions of "The Waste Lands Act, 1858;" and from and after the date of the publication of such Proclamation, the whole or part, as the case may be, of such lands shall be liable to be dealt with in all respects as if no such reserve had ever been made. Governor in Council may withdraw land from reservation under "Waste Lands Act, 1858."
