A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to Extend the Time for the Exercise of Volunteer Scrip in the Province of Wellington.

WHEREAS by "The Volunteers Land Act 1865 Amendment Act, 1873," (hereinafter called "the said Act") it was enacted that all claims for remission to which the applicants were then entitled, and all claims for exercise of scrip already issued, should be barred unless made within twelve months of the passing of the said Act: And whereas it was deemed expedient to withdraw from sale certain blocks of land in the Province of Wellington: And whereas it is expedient that the time for the exercise of scrip within the said province should be extended:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Wellington Volunteers Scrip Act Extension Act, 1874."

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the said Act, all claims for the grant of remission certificates to Volunteers or others entitled thereto under "The Volunteers Land Act, 1865," within the Province of Wellington, and all claims for the exercise of scrip already issued under the last-mentioned Act, and exercisable within the said province, may be exercised at any time within two years from the passing of this Act: Provided that all such claims as aforesaid shall be barred, unless made or exercised within two years from the date of the passing of this Act.
