APPRENTICES AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. SMITH, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 5, subclause (1): To add the following proviso:—

Provided that nothing in this subsection or in any order of the Court thereunder shall confer power on a District Registrar to make any recommendation with respect to the making or amendment by the Court of an order under section five of the principal Act.

Clause 15: To omit the words “by adding the following as subsection two thereof:—”, and substituting the following:—

“as follows:—

“(a) By inserting, after the words ‘any reason’, the words ‘(including the completion of his contract of apprenticeship)’:

“(b) By adding the following as subsection two thereof.”

To insert the following new clause:—

9A. Every employer shall within three days after engaging any person as an apprentice give notice of such engagement to the District Registrar for the locality concerned.
