ACCIDENT REHABILITATION AND COMPENSATION INSURANCE BILL

Proposed Amendments

Rt. Hon. W. F. BIRCH, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 37 (2): To omit the expression "1/52nd of" (page 47, line 6). To add the words "divided by the number of weeks in that income year".

Clause 83: To omit this clause (page 85, lines 1 to 13), and substitute the following clause:

88. No compensation, grant, or allowance to imprisoned person—In respect of any period during which any person is an inmate in any penal institution within the meaning of the Penal Institutions Act 1954, no compensation, grant, or allowance shall be payable under this Act to that person.

Clause 108 (1): To omit the words "Consolidated Account" (page 104, line 8), and substitute the words "Crown Bank Account".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Clause 37 (2): The amendment amends the method of calculating weekly earnings under this clause.

Clause 83: The amendment reinstates and clarifies the previous clause.

Clause 108 (1): The amendment changes an incorrect reference to the Consolidated Account to the Crown Bank Account.
