Proposed amendments

Mita Ririnui, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 2

To omit this clause (lines 9 to 12 on page 4), and substitute the following clause:

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on **14 October 2001**.

Clause 3

To omit from the definition of **Māori constituency** the words “the Māori constituency established by **section 5** or” (lines 24 and 25 on page 4).

Clause 4 (as proposed to be amended by Supplementary Order Paper No 152)

To omit this clause (lines 4 to 15 on page 5), and substitute the following clause:

4 Act to be read with Local Government Act 1974 and Local Electoral Act 2001

- (1) This Act is to be read in conjunction with the Local Government Act 1974 and the Local Electoral Act 2001, and those Acts and any regulations made under those Acts apply accordingly and with any necessary modifications.
- (2) However, if there is any inconsistency between the provisions of this Act and any provisions in either of the other Acts referred to in **subsection (1)** or any regulations made under those Acts, this Act prevails.

Explanatory note

These proposed amendments (which, amongst other things, replace the amendments made to *clause 4* by Supplementary Order Paper 152) are consequential on a Supplementary Order that omits the provisions of the Bill that provide for the 2001 triennial general election of the Bay of Plenty Regional Council to be conducted with a Māori constituency (*Part 1* and *clauses 18 and 19*).
