

## SUPPLEMENTARY ORDER PAPER.

#### COUNTIES ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. Hogg, in Committee, to move the following new clauses :—

*A.* Every road (including a main road and a county road), street, and other public highway traversing or lying within a town district shall be deemed a street of such town district, and shall vest in the corporation thereof and be under the exclusive control of the Board of Commissioners thereof.

*B.* (1.) Where an area not forming part of a road district is constituted a town district, the like apportionments shall be made between the county and the town district as are by section eleven of "The Town Districts Act, 1881," directed to be made between a road district and town district.

(2.) The provisions of sections eleven to fifteen (inclusive) of such Act shall extend and apply to the case of such constitution of a town district as aforesaid, the county and the County Council being deemed substituted for the road district and Road Board respectively, and all other necessary amendments being deemed made in such provisions.

(3.) This section shall apply to all town districts heretofore constituted as aforesaid.
