COMPANIES AMENDMENT BILL NO. 2

Proposed Amendments

Hon. Mr McLAY, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

That *clauses 17 and 18* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 17* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Incorporated Societies Act 1908

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Incorporated Societies Amendment Act 1983, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Incorporated Societies Act 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That *clauses 19 to 23* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 19* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Industrial and Provident Societies Act 1908

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Industrial and Provident Societies Amendment Act 1983 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Industrial and Provident Societies Act 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This paper breaks the Bill into 3 component portions and enables each to be enacted as a separate Act.
