CEMETERIES BILL.

Hon. Mr. ROLLESTON, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 47. Immediately before the clause to insert the following:—

New Clause.

47a. Every denomination may from time to time appoint and remove Managers of any burial-ground belonging to such denomination in any case where no special enactment relating to such burial ground provides a different mode of appointment.

Clause 47. To add the following words: "And the said Managers may exercise the rights, powers, and duties aforesaid, notwithstanding that the legal estate in the burial-ground for which they are appointed is not vested in them."

Clause 74a. To omit the words from "person," in line 1, to the word "made," in line 2, and to substitute the following: "who has acquired a plot of ground wherein no interment has been made, or wherefrom no body has been removed, in any cemetery or burial-ground which is closed by any such order." Last line. To omit the word "general."
