PROPERTY LAW AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Major Steward, in Committee, to move the addition of the following new clause:—

New clause.

No mortgagee shall be entitled to charge a perusal fee in respect of a simple reconveyance, release, or discharge of a mortgage which contains no special terms or provisions.

CRIMINAL CODE ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Major Steward, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

Section 2, subparagraph 6: Add at the end the words "in blood." Also, add the following new subparagraph—viz., "Aunt and nephew in blood."

RATING ACT AMENDMENT.

Mr. Hall to move the following new clause:—

Notwithstanding anything contained in "The Rating Act, 1894," and its amendments, no person who shall after the passing of this Act become the holder of a lease in perpetuity or of an occupation license with right of purchase of any section of Crown land wholly covered with bush or scrub, not exceeding three hundred acres in area, shall be liable to pay rates for three years after the date on which such land was selected.
