CONSERVATION LAW REFORM BILL

Proposed Motion to Divide Bill into 8 Separate Bills

Hon. PHILLIP WOOLLASTON, in Committee, to move as follows:

That *Part I (clauses 2 to 39)* and the *Schedule* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 2* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Conservation Act 1987

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Conservation Amendment Act (No. 3) 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Conservation Act 1987 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, this Act shall come into force on the day on which it receives the Royal assent.

(3) Sections 6A and 6L of the principal Act (as inserted by section 5 of this Act), sections 26B and 26O of the principal Act (as inserted by section 17 of this Act), and sections 34, 35A, 37, and 38 of this Act shall come into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council.

That *Part II (clauses 40 to 72)* be a separate Bill with the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to consolidate and amend the law relating to walkways in New Zealand

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the New Zealand Walkways Act 1990.

That *Part III (clauses 73 to 83B)* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 73* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Marine Reserves Act 1971

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Marine Reserves Amendment Act 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Marine Reserves Act 1971 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That *Part IV (clauses 84 to 109)* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 84* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Wildlife Act 1953

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Wildlife Amendment Act 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Wildlife Act 1953 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) Except as otherwise provided in this Act, this Act shall come into force on the day on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part V (clauses 110 to 126)* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 110* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Reserves Act 1977

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Reserves Amendment Act (No. 2) 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Reserves Act 1977 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That *Part VI (clauses 127 to 129)* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 127* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Marine Mammals Protection Act 1978

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Marine Mammals Protection Amendment Act 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Marine Mammals Protection Act 1978 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That *Part VII (clauses 130 to 148)* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 130* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the National Parks Act 1980

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the National Parks Amendment Act (No. 2) 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the National Parks Act 1980 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) Except as otherwise provided in this Act, this Act shall come into force on the day on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part VIII (clauses 149 to 167)* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 149* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Fisheries Act 1983

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Fisheries Amendment Act (No. 2) 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries Act 1983 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The proposed motion, which is set out in the Supplementary Order Paper, divides the Conservation Law Reform Bill into 8 separate Bills.
