CIVIL SERVICE BILL.

Mr. TAYLOR, in Committee, to move,—

That all persons who are ignored under the Bill, such as those who have been in the employment of the Government for a number of years, performing manual labour, also mechanics, artificers, and others, shall be placed upon the same footing as those called “permanent employés” in the Government Printing Office.

ELECTORAL BILL.

Mr. TAYLOR, in Committee, to move,—

That the same electoral privileges which are granted under the Act to commercial travellers and shearers shall also be granted to engine-drivers and others whose duties prevent them from voting upon polling-day where they reside.
