PUBLIC REVENUES BILL.

Hon. Mr. Ward, to move the following addition to clause 2:—

No person, body, or authority from whom the whole or any Lenders not bound part of such sum shall be borrowed as aforesaid shall be concerned to see what amounts previously to see or inquire whether or to what extent the power hereby given borrowed. has been previously exercised or is intended to be exercised; and any money borrowed under the authority of this Act shall, so far as the lender is concerned, be deemed to be within the powers conferred in that behalf, and to have been lawfully borrowed accordingly.

LAND AND INCOME ASSESSMENT ACTS AMENDMENT.

Hon. Mr. Ward, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

To be inserted after clause 8 of the Bill:—

9. Section nine of "The Land and Income Assessment Act Amendment of Amendment Act, 1892," is hereby amended as follows: Where the Land and Income word "April" first occurs in the said section, the word "July" is Assessment Act Amendment Act, hereby substituted.

At the end of the first paragraph of the said section nine the

following new paragraph is inserted:

In order to give effect to the preceding provisions, the Com- Power to require owners and mortmissioner may from time to time require any person, to make a gagees to make cerreturn in writing of any land owned or mortgages held by or vested in tain returns. such person as at the first day of April, in the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-three, or as at the first day of April in any succeeding year, as the case may require; and the particulars to be inserted in such returns, and the mode of making the same, may be prescribed from time to time by regulations made under the original Act.

In section 15 of the Bill: In paragraph (1), strike out the words "allowing for," and insert the words "deducting the value of."

On page 8 of the Bill, paragraph (6), subclause (b), strike out in (j) the words "nor on account of any interest paid on any mortgage."

CIVIL SERVICE INSURANCE BILL.

Hon. Mr. Ward, in Committee, to move:

To insert a new subsection to section 18, as follows:—

(6.) All clerks, artizans, workmen, and other persons in the temporary employment of the Government.
