FIREARMS BILL.

Mr. REID, in Committee, to move the following new clauses :—

- License to carry a firearm. 5A. Every person over the age of fifteen years who shall carry or have in his possession any firearm, or any kind of ammunition for a firearm, shall provide himself with a license as hereinafter set forth.
- Local authority to make regulations. 5B. Such license shall upon application be issued to such person by the local authority of the district in which the applicant resides, and the Governor may from time to time, by Order in Council gazetted, make regulations regarding the grant of such licenses and the fees to be paid therefor, not exceeding *two shillings and sixpence* for each such license.
- Inspection of license. 5C. Any ratepayer in a local district may demand such license for inspection from any person carrying any firearm upon or adjoining the land of such ratepayer.
