FINANCE BILL (NO. 4)

Proposed Motion to Divide Bill into 10 Bills

Hon. Peter Neilson, in Committee, to move as follows:

That clauses 1 to 11 be a separate Bill; and that for clause 1 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to make provision with respect to public finances and other matters

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Finance Act (No. 4) 1990.

(2) Except as provided in section 8 (6) of this Act, this Act shall come into force on the day on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *clauses 12 and 13* be a separate Bill; and that for *clause 12* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Carriage by Air Act 1967

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Carriage by Air Amendment Act (No. 2) 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Carriage by Air Act 1967.

That *clauses 14 to 16* be a separate Bill; and that for *clause 14* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Customs Act 1966

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

- 1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Customs Amendment Act (No. 2) 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Customs Act 1966.
- (2) Except as provided in section 16 (2) of this Act, this Act shall come into force on the day on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *clauses 17 to 18* be a separate Bill; and that for *clause 17* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Education Act 1989

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

- 1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Education Amendment Act (No. 2) 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education Act 1989.
- (2) Except as provided in sections 18 (3) and 18 (4) of this Act, this Act shall come into force on the day on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *clauses 19* and 20 be a separate Bill; and that for *clause 19* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Harbours Act 1950

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Harbours Amendment Act 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Harbours Act 1950.

That *clauses 21 to 31* be a separate Bill; and that for *clause 21* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Port Companies Act 1988

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Port Companies Amendment Act 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Port Companies Act 1988 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That *clauses 32 to 35* be a separate Bill; and that for *clause 32* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952 BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

- 1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Shipping and Seamen Amendment Act 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
- (2) This Act shall come into force on the 15th day of September 1990.

That *clauses 36 to 39* be a separate Bill; and that for *clause 36* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Transit New Zealand Act 1989 BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Transit New Zealand Amendment Act 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Transit New Zealand Act 1989 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That clauses 40 to 48 be a separate Bill; and that for clause 40 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Transport Services Licensing Act 1989

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Transport Services Licensing Amendment Act 1990, and shall be read

together with and deemed part of the Transport Services Licensing Act 1989 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That *clauses 49 and 50* be a separate Bill; and that for *clause 49* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the United Nations Act 1946

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the United Nations Amendment Act 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the United Nations Act 1946 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
