INDUSTRIAL CONCILIATION AND ARBITRATION AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. FRASER, in Committee, to move to insert the following new clauses:—

Application for
Dominion
awards.

12. Any industrial union of workers registered as an amalgamated industrial union under the provisions of this Act may, upon the expiration or sooner determination of the award or industrial agreements affecting the members of such amalgamated union, from time to time enter into industrial agreements for the Dominion of New Zealand or apply to the Court for a Dominion award, and the Court may, upon such application, join and bind as portion thereto all industrial associations and employers in New Zealand who are connected with or engaged in the same industry as that to which the application applies.

Provision to
prevent
multiplicity
of unions.

13. The provisions of section eleven of the principal Act shall apply, *mutatis mutandis*, to amalgamated unions, and the Registrar may refuse to register an industrial union in any case where he is of opinion that there exists an amalgamated union to which members of such industrial union might conveniently belong.

14. The Governor-General shall appoint a Dominion Clerk of Awards, and such Dominion Clerk shall be subject to the control and direction of the Registrar.
