INDUSTRIAL CONCILIATION AND ARBITRATION AMENDMENT BILL

Mr. MOOHAN, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

Clause 3, subclause (1) (i): To insert after the word "other" in line 22 the words "secret ballot or other".

Mr. R. MACDONALD, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

Clause 3, subclause (1): To add the following new subparagraph:—

(iii) Where the Registrar makes a decision prescribing a method of election or appointment of a Committee of management and officers of a society or an industrial union, the society or industrial union may appeal against the decision to the Court.

Miss HOWARD, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

Clause 7, subclause (3): To omit the words "Social Security Fund" in lines 20 and 21 and to substitute therefor the words "the Union's Charitable Fund or Benevolent Fund, as the case may be".

Hon. Mr. McLAGAN, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

Clause 19, subclause (1): To omit all the words after the word "workers" in line 12, and to substitute therefor the following:—

- (a) With intent to compel or induce any such employer to agree to terms of employment, or comply with any demands made by the said or any other workers; or
- (b) With intent to cause loss or inconvenience to any such employer in the conduct of his business; or
- (c) With intent to incite, aid, abet, instigate or procure any strike; or
- (d) With intent to assist workers in the employment of any other employer or compel or induce that employer to agree to terms of employment or comply with any demands made upon him by any workers.

Mr. COTTERILL, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

Clause 24, subclause (2A): To add, after the word "workers" in each instance where it occurs in line 34, the words "or employers":
