IMPORTATION OF MEDICINES BILL

Proposed Motion to Divide Bill into 3 Bills

Hon. DAVID BUTCHER, in Committee, to move as follows:

That *clauses 2 and 3* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 2* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Medicines Act 1981

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Medicines Amendment Act (No. 2) 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Medicines Act 1981 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That *clauses 6 and 7* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 6* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Trade Marks Act 1953

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Trade Marks Amendment Act 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Trade Marks Act 1953 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That clauses 8 to 12 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 8 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Copyright Act 1962

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Copyright Amendment Act 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Copyright Act 1962 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Supplementary Order Paper divides the Importation of Medicines Bill into 3 separate Bills.
