WOMEN'S SUFFRAGE BILL.

Mr. Ivess, in Committee, to move that clause 2 be amended as follows:—

2. Subsection one of section two of "The Qualification of Electors Act, 1879," is hereby amended as follows, that is to say, after the words "every man," at the beginning of the said subsection, the words "and woman" shall be inserted.
