INDUSTRIAL UNIONS AND TRADE UNIONS ENABLING BILL.

Mr. ANDERSON, in Committee, to move the following clause in substitution for the new clause 8 as recommended by the Labour Bills Committee :---

Offence.

8. Every person is liable to a fine not exceeding *five* pounds who uses any threatening, abusive, or insulting words or behaviour towards any member of a labour-union who has exercised his right under this Act of objecting to contribute to the political fund of the union, if such words or behaviour have reference to the objection of the member to contribute as aforesaid.
