MUTUAL ASSISTANCE IN CRIMINAL MATTERS BILL

Proposed Motion to Divide Bill into 3 Separate Bills

Hon. D. A. M. GRAHAM, in Committee, to move as follows:

That *Parts I to IV* be a separate Bill with the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

An Act to facilitate the provision and obtaining of international assistance in criminal matters

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters Act 1992.

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1993.

That *Part V* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 65* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

An Act to amend the Proceeds of Crime Act 1991

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Proceeds of Crime Amendment Act 1992, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Proceeds of Crime Act 1991 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, this Act shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1993.

(3) Sections 71, 71A, and 73 of this Act shall come into force on the day after the date on which this Act receives the Royal assent.

That *Part VI* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 76* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

An Act to amend the Immigration Act 1987

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Immigration Amendment Act 1992, and shall be

read together with and deemed part of the Immigration Act 1987 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the **1st day of April 1993**.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Supplementary Order Paper contains the appropriate motion to divide the Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters Bill into 3 separate Bills—The Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters Bill, the Proceeds of Crime Amendment Bill, and the Immigration Amendment Bill.
