JURIES AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. ALLEN, in Committee, to move the following amendment in :—

Clause 4 : At the beginning of the clause to insert the following words :—

“ Subsection twelve of section six of the principal Act is hereby amended by striking out the words ‘on actual service,’ ‘while on actual service in the field,’ ‘when called out and on actual service.’ ”

And the addition of the following new clause :—

New Clause.

4A. Section seven of the principal Act is hereby amended by striking out the words “except Volunteers and Militiamen, whose names shall be inserted in the jury-lists, but who shall not be summoned while on actual service.”

MORTGAGES BILL.

Hon. Major STEWARD, in Committee, to move the following amendment :—

To strike out clause four as printed, and substitute the following, viz. :—

4. The price of such forms shall be such sum as shall be appointed by Order in Council and published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, but shall not exceed the following rate or scale—namely: Two shillings and sixpence for every hundred pounds or part of one hundred pounds of the amount of the mortgage in, by, or upon any such form to be expressed or effected.
