THAMES WATER SUPPLY TRANSFER BILL.

Mr. Speight, in Committee, to move the following new clause:

10. The said water-race so vested in the said county shall be kept in good repair by and at the expense of the Council of said county; and, if not so kept in good repair, to the satisfaction of the Minister of Public Works, the Governor may from time to time cause the same to be repaired out of any moneys payable to the said county by or through the Government of New Zealand, from whatsoever source such moneys may accrue.

MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. Stewart, in Committee, to move the following new clause:

It shall be lawful for all persons to whom the district Board and rate-payers of the Half-Way Bush Road District are or shall be indebted, to lodge particulars of their debts with the Controller and Auditor-General, who shall notify to the Corporations of the Boroughs of Maori Hill and Roslyn respectively the amounts of such debts.

In case the said Corporations of the Boroughs of Maori Hill or Roslyn shall neglect or fail within three months after such notification to satisfy the said debts, it shall be lawful for the Supreme Court of New Zealand, at the instance of any or either of the said creditors, to make an order that such corporations shall levy a special rate for the purpose of paying such debts as aforesaid.

COUNTIES ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. Murray, in Committee, to move the following new clause:-

It shall be lawful for the Councils of two or more counties to unite for the construction, repair, use, and maintenance of bridges, roads, tramways, and ferries in any of such counties.
