MAGISTRATE'S COURT BILL.

Mr. Sandford to move the following new clause:

A Magistrate may appoint a fit and proper person to act as bailiff under "The Distress and Replevin Act, 1868," within the district over which the Magistrate has jurisdiction, and such appointment from time to time may revoke; and it shall not be lawful for any person to act as bailiff under "The Distress and Replevin Act, 1868," unless such person has been appointed by the Magistrate as hereinbefore mentioned.
