MENTAL DEFECTIVES BILL.

Hon. Mr. Fowlds, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

To add the following new clause:—

Education of mentally defective children.

- 29A. Nothing in this Act shall affect the provisions of section eleven of the Education Amendment Act, 1910 (relating to epileptic and feeble-minded children), and any minor received into an institution under this Act may be sent to any special school within the meaning of that section, and shall thereupon be subject to the provisions of the Education Amendment Act, 1910, and shall cease to be subject to the provisions of this Part of this Act.
- Clause 37 (7): To omit the words "of unsound mind" in line 49, and substitute the words "mentally defective."
- Clause 42 (5): To omit the word "Governor," and substitute the word "Minister."
 - Clause 42: To add the following subclause:—
 - (8.) The Minister may at his discretion transfer any Superintendent, Medical Officer, or Assistant Medical Officer from any one institution to another.
 - Clause 43: To add the following subclause:—
 - (2A.) Any land or building at any time added to an institution shall be deemed to form part of that institution.
