Clause 65: To omit this clause, and substitute the following clause:

65. Costs—(1) Where on any petition an alleged adulterer or adulteress has been made a co-respondent and the adultery has been established, the Court may order him or her to pay the whole or any part of the costs of the proceedings.

(2) Subject to the foregoing provisions of this Act relating to costs, the Court on the hearing of any proceedings under this Act may make such order as to costs as to the Court seems just.
