MAORI PURPOSES BILL

Proposed Amendments

Hon. K. T. WETERE, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

That clauses 4 and 5 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 4 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Maori Affairs Act 1953

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. **Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Maori Affairs Amendment Act (No. 2) 1985, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Maori Affairs Act 1953 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That clauses 8 to 9B be a separate Bill, and that for clause 8 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Maori Housing Act 1935

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. **Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Maori Housing Amendment Act 1985, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Maori Housing Act 1935 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That clauses 10 to 14 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 10 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Maori Trustee Act 1953

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. **Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Maori Trustee Amendment Act 1985, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Maori Trustee Act 1953 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The amendments break the Bill up into its component parts for final enactment as 4 separate Acts.
