OATHS AND DECLARATIONS BILL

*Proposed Amendments*

Hon. Mr MARSHALL, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 11: To insert in subclause (1), after the words "of Oaths" in line 1 on page 6, the words "a notary public".

Third Schedule: To add the words "The Assistant Controller and Auditor-General".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*Clause 11:* The effect of this amendment will be that a declaration made in any Commonwealth country other than New Zealand may be made before a notary public.

*Third Schedule:* The effect of this amendment will be that the Assistant Controller and Auditor-General will also be required to take the Official Oath prescribed by *clause 21* of the Bill.
