PUBLIC HEALTH AMENDMENT.

Hon. Mr. Russell, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 27: To omit the words "district fund," and substitute the words "ordinary funds"; and to add the following words:—

"or for the establishment and maintenance of bursaries to medical and dental students at any college affiliated to the New Zealand University.

"(2.) For the purposes of this section 'local authority' includes any governing authority or body which expends public money."

To insert the following new clause:—

Section 79 of principal Act amended. 29a. Section seventy-nine of the Public Health Act, 1908, is

hereby amended by inserting the following proviso:—

"Provided that in any district where the Minister is satisfied the local authority is satisfactorily enforcing the provisions of the principal Act and safeguarding the public health, he may, for such period as he thinks fit, delegate to such local authority such or all of the powers conferred by the principal Act on the District Health Officer as he thinks fit"
