PUBLIC WORKS ACTS AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. MITCHELSON, on the Bill being recommitted, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 8, page 4, between lines 10 and 11, after the words “may be,” insert the following new paragraph:—

Provided, however, that no such occupier or owner shall be compelled to clear plants off such road unless plants of similar character to those he is ordered to clear off the road shall be, or shall shortly before such order have been, growing in the fences or on the lands of the said occupier or owner adjoining such road.

Mr. Ross, on the Bill being recommitted, to move the following new clause:—

Whereas some doubt exists as to the power of Harbour Boards to expend any part of their revenue in constructing streets, it is hereby enacted that, whenever it shall have been agreed between any Harbour Board and the local body having jurisdiction over any land which may have been reclaimed from the sea by the said Harbour Board to construct any street or streets over such reclaimed land, it shall be lawful for the Harbour Board to contribute out of its revenue such proportion of the cost of the construction of any such street or streets as may be agreed on by the said public bodies.
