NOTICES RELATING TO ORDERS OF THE DAY.

RAILWAYS CONSTRUCTION BILL.

Mr. OLIVER, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

The Governor in Council may enter into arrangements with any person or company willing to carry on and complete the construction of a railway from the City of Wellington to the Manawatu River, or to the crossing to Paramatta, in the Porirua Harbour, on such terms and conditions as he may deem expedient; and may grant, convey and assign, to such person or company all such land, rails, bridge, plant, and other material as have been purchased or acquired on behalf of Her Majesty for the purposes of such railway: Provided always this Act shall not authorize the Governor to guarantee or authorize the payment or expenditure of any money not voted by the Legislature for the purposes of such railway.
