TOURIST AND HEALTH RESORTS CONTROL BILL.

Hon. Sir J. G. Ward, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—
Clause 5: After the word "hereto," in line 27, insert the words "or2of any reserve brought under this Act."

To insert new clause:—

Reserves may be brought under Act. 5a. The Governor may from time to time, by Order in Council gazetted, bring under this Act any reserve or domain now or at any time hereafter made or administered under "The Public Reserves Act, 1881," "The Public Domains Act, 1881," "The Thermal Springs Act, 1881," "The New Zealand State Forests Act, 1885," "The Land Act, 1892," "The Scenery Preservation Act, 1903," or or "The Queenstown Reserves Act, 1905," notwithstanding anything to the contrary in those Acts, and such reserve or domain shall thereafter be administered under this Act.
