Tertiary Education Reform Bill

Proposed motion to divide Bill into 2 Bills

Hon Steve Maharey, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, clause 1, Part 1, Part 2, and Schedules 1 and 2 be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words, clause 1, the Part 1 heading, clause 2, the Part 2 heading, and clause 4 there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title
- (1) This Act is the Education (Tertiary Reform) Amendment Act **2002**.
- (2) In this Act, the Education Act 1989 is called "the principal Act".
- 2 Commencement
- (1) This Act, other than the sections referred to in subsections (2) to (4), comes into force on 1 January 2003.
- (2) Section 15AA comes into force on 1 July 2003.
- (3) Sections 12, 13, 13A, and 17 come into force on 1 January 2004.
- (4) **Sections 17A to 17D** come into force on the day after the date on which this Act receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 3* and *Schedules 3 and 4* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 3* heading and *clause 38* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title
- (1) This Act is the Industry Training Amendment Act 2002.
- (2) In this Act, the Industry Training Act 1992² is called "the principal Act".

- 2 Commencement
- (1) This Act, other than the sections referred to in **subsection (2)**, comes into force on **1 January 2003**.
- (2) Sections 39(3) and (4), 40(1), (2), and (4), 41(1) and (2), 42(1), (2), and (5), 43, 44(2), (6), (7), and (8), 45A, 45B, 45C, 45E, and 46A come into force on 1 January 2004.

Explanatory note

This Supplementary Order Paper replaces Supplementary Order Paper No 24, which was released on 15 October 2002. The replacement is necessary to reflect a change to the commencement dates. The Supplementary Order Paper divides the Tertiary Education Reform Bill into the following 2 Bills:

- the Education (Tertiary Reform) Amendment Bill:
- the Industry Training Amendment Bill.
