## Transport Legislation Bill

---

### *Proposed motion to divide Bill into 4 Bills*

Hon Pete Hodgson, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the *enacting words, clauses 1 and 2, and subpart 1 of Part 1* be a separate Bill, and that for *clauses 1 to 3, and the headings before clause 3*, there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Civil Aviation Amendment Act **2004**.
- (2) In this Act, the Civil Aviation Act 1990<sup>1</sup> is called “the principal Act”.

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on **1 December 2004**.

That *subpart 2 of Part 1 and Schedule 1* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 15 and the heading before that clause* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Land Transport Amendment Act **2004**.
- (2) In this Act, the Land Transport Act 1998<sup>2</sup> is called “the principal Act”.

**2 Commencement**

- (1) **Section 18A** comes into force on **1 July 2005**.

- (2) The rest of this Act comes into force on **1 December 2004**.

That *subpart 3 of Part 1, Part 2, Schedule 2, Schedule 4, and Schedule 5* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 24* and the heading before that clause there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Land Transport Management Amendment Act **2004**.
- (2) In this Act, the Land Transport Management Act 2003<sup>3</sup> is called “the principal Act”.

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on **1 December 2004**.

That *subpart 4 of Part 1 and Schedule 3* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 39* and the heading before that clause there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Maritime Transport Amendment Act **2004**.
- (2) In this Act, the Maritime Transport Act 1994<sup>4</sup> is called “the principal Act”.

**2 Commencement**

- (1) **Section 49** comes into force on **1 July 2005**.
- (2) The rest of this Act comes into force on **1 December 2004**.
