War Pensions Amendment Bill (No 2)

Proposed amendments

Hon George Hawkins, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Schedule 1

To omit *new Schedule 11* (lines 3 to 23 on page 23), and substitute the following Schedule:

Schedule 11 Rates of Veterans' Pensions

ss 74, 74U

To omit *new Schedule 12* (lines 1 to 26 on page 24), and substitute the following Schedule:

Schedule 12 s 74A Payments on death of veteran or veteran's spouse

- 1 (a) on the death of a person who,-
 - on the date of his or her death, was in receipt of a veteran's pension on account of his or her own service; and
 - (ii) before 1 April 1990, was in receipt of a war veteran's allowance under the War Pensions Act 1954
 - (b) on the death of any person who, on the date of his or her death, was in receipt of a veteran's pension on account of his or her own service
 - (c) on the death of the spouse of any person if that person is receiving a veteran's pension on account of his or her own service and if the spouse was in receipt of a veteran's pension
- There is deductable from any amount payable under clause 1 the amount of any veteran's pension paid or payable in respect of the person who has died following their death.

\$11,291.07 to the surviving spouse of that person, or, if there is no surviving spouse, to be apportioned equally between any dependent children of that person

\$4,478.06 to the surviving spouse of that person or, if there is no surviving spouse, to be apportioned equally between any dependent children of that person \$3,414.65 to that person

Explanatory note

This Supplementary Order Paper proposes to amend *new Schedule 11* (which relates to rates of veterans' pensions) and *new Schedule 12* (which relates to payments on death of a veteran or a veterans' spouse) to adjust the rates in line with an increase of 2.72% in the All Groups Consumer Price Index.
