### **Regulations**

#### **1 Title**

These regulations are the Administration (Fee) Amendment Regulations (No 3) 2001.

#### **2 Commencement**

These regulations come into force on 28 September 2001.

### 3 Commencement of Administration (Fee) Amendment Regulations 2001

Regulation 2 of the Administration (Fee) Amendment Regulations 2001 is amended by omitting the expression “1 October”, and substituting the expression “15 October”.

### 4 Revocation

The Administration (Fee) Amendment Regulations (No 2) 2001 (SR 2001/167) are consequentially revoked.

### Explanatory note

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 28 September 2001, defer the commencement of the Administration (Fee) Amendment Regulations 2001 (SR 2001/104) for a further 14 days. The effect of the deferral is that, until 15 October 2001, the fee payable for the issue of a certificate of administration under section 18 of the Administration Act 1969 will continue to be \$20.
